I am writing this letter to inform you of my intention to terminate my Professional Services Agreement with the county for Owner's Representative Services for the new Archuleta County Courthouse. The date of the termination will be effective January 25th, 2021, unless given written permission to do so sooner. It is clear to me that the county doesn't feel that the services of a Project Manager are useful for the construction of the courthouse building, and I feel that future professional service fees that I would charge could be put to better use on other costs for the project.

Please be advised that one of the conditions of the funding through the Underfunded Courts grant was that the county retain the services of a qualified Project Manager. With your permission I would be more than happy to work with representatives from Colorado Judicial to negotiate a different approach to project oversight and reporting that could possibly work for all parties. I would perform these services Pro Bono, and hopefully they would be a success.
