



**PROCLAMATION BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS  
OF ARCHULETA COUNTY, COLORADO**

**WHEREAS**, it is the privilege and duty of the American people to commemorate our nation's founding document on this the two hundred thirty fourth anniversary of the drafting of the Constitution of the United States of America with appropriate ceremonies and activities; and,

**WHEREAS**, Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17-23 as **Constitution Week**. Citizens, leaders and officials are encouraged to conduct ceremonies and programs that bring together community members to reflect on the importance of active citizenship, recognize the enduring strength of our Constitution, and reaffirm our commitment to the rights and obligations of citizenship in this great Nation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Sarah Platt Decker Chapter of the National Society Daughters of the American Revolution hereby celebrate, honor and reflect on the fundamental document of the United States of America and the patriots who sacrificed so much to create this Nation.

**THEREFORE, THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF ARCHULETA COUNTY, COLORADO DO HEREBY PROCLAIM THE FOLLOWING:**

- 1) We declare the week of September 17-23, 2021 as Constitution Week in Archuleta County.
- 2) We urge all citizens to study the Constitution, and reflect on the privilege of being an American with all the rights and responsibilities, which that privilege involves.
