### **Local:**

#### **Alternative Horizons \* 247-9619**

Provides confidential support for victims of domestic violence. Spanish-speaking advocates are available.

#### **Mental Health Crisis Line \* 247-5245**

Provides support for those experiencing distressing emotions, such as intense anxiety, depression, or thoughts of suicide. Conversations are confidential. Trained therapists are available.

#### **Rape Intervention Team \* 247-5400**

Provides assistance for sexual assault victims. Spanish-speaking support personnel are available.

### **National:**

#### **Domestic Violence \* 1-800-799-SAFE (7233)**

Provides crisis intervention and referral to local services and shelters for victims of partner or spousal abuse. English and Spanish-speaking advocates are available. Many staff members speak languages besides English, and they have 24-hour access to translators for approximately 150 languages. For the hearing impaired, there is a TDD number. This is a great resource for anyone—man, woman or child—who is experiencing or has experienced domestic violence or abuse, or who suspects that someone they know is being abused.

#### **National Runaway Switchboard \* 1-800-621-4000**

Provides crisis intervention and travel assistance to runaways. Provides information and local referrals to adolescents and families. Gives referrals to shelters nationwide. Also relays messages to, or sets up conference calls with, parents at the request of the child.

#### **National Youth Crisis Hotline \* 1-800-442-HOPE (4673)**

Provides counseling and referrals to local drug treatment centers, shelters, and counseling services. Responds to youth dealing with pregnancy, molestation, suicide, and child abuse.

#### **Suicide Prevention \* 1-800-SUICIDE (784-2433)**

The “Hopeline” is dedicated to sharing the message that suicide is not the answer and that help is always available. Staff members share the most current news and information to educate about mental illness, and to connect callers to crucial information that will assist in getting help for themselves or a loved one.
