ORDINANCE NO. 1-1289

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REGULATION OF SPEED ON PIEDRA ROAD, ARCHULETA COUNTY, COLORADO.

Be It Ordained By The Board of County Commissioners of the County of Archuleta, State of Colorado, as follows:

SECTION 1.00 TITLE

1.01 This Ordinance shall be known as the Piedra Road Speed Regulation Ordinance.

SECTION 2.00 PURPOSE

2.01 This Ordinance is for the purpose of protecting the citizens of Archuleta County, Colorado, by regulating the speed on that Archuleta County Road known as Piedra Road.

SECTION 3.00 AUTHORITY

3.01 The authority of the Board of County Commissioners of Archuleta County, Colorado to establish and/or alter the existing speed limits on Piedra Road derives from Colorado Revised Statute Section 42-4-108 and 42-4-109, et seq. and said sections are specifically incorporated herein by reference and shall not be limited by any language contained in this ordinance.

SECTION 4.00 SPEED LIMITS ESTABLISHED

- 4.01 The Board of County Commissioners of Archuleta County, Colorado, hereby establishes and/or alters the existing speed limit to the following speed limits for vehicular travel on that Archuleta County road known as Piedra Road:
- 4.01(a) The speed limit for vehicular traffic from the intersection of U.S. Highway 160 and Piedra Road to the intersection of Piedra Road and Stirrup Drive shall be and is thirty-five (35) miles per hour, except when condition warrant a lower speed.
- 4.01(b) The speed limit for vehicular traffic from the intersection of Piedra Road and Stirrup Drive to the end of Piedra Road shall be and is forty (40) miles per hour, except when conditions warrant a lower speed.

SECTION 5.00 EFFECTIVE DATE

5.01 This Ordinance shall be effective upon adoption by the Board of County Commissioners of Archuleta County, Colorado, after proper legal process and placement of official signs conforming to state standards as prescribed by C.R.S. § 42-4-503 and upon giving notice of such regulation pursuant to C.R.S. § 42-4-109(2).

SECTION 6.00 ENFORCEMENT

- 6.01 The Sheriff of Archuleta County, Colorado and duly authorized deputies of said Sheriff shall be charged with the enforcement of this ordinance.
- 6.02 The officers of the Colorado State Patrol shall have concurrent authority to enforce this ordinance.

SECTION 7.00 PENALTY

- 7.01 The summons and complaint issued to persons for the violation of the ordinance shall be filed in the County Court of Archuleta County, Colorado, and the persons so cited shall be tried in said Court. All persons found guilty of violating this ordinance shall be fined an amount not to exceed Three Hundred and no/100 Dollars (\$300.00) in the discretion of the Judges of the County Court of Archuleta County, Colorado, plus the costs of Court.
- 7.02 All fines collected from violation of the provision of this ordinance shall be directed to the Treasurer of Archuleta County, Colorado who shall deposit said sums in the Archuleta County General Fund.

SECTION 8.00 JURISDICTIONAL AREA

 $\,$ 8.01 $\,$ The provisions of this ordinance shall apply only to that Archuleta County Road known as Piedra Road.

SECTION 9.00 CONFLICTS

9.01 This Ordinance does not conflict with any statute or provisions thereof of the State of Colorado.

SECTION 10.00 VALIDITY AND SEVERABILITY

10.01 Should Any section, clause, sentence or part of this ordinance be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, the same shall not affect the

validity of the ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part so declared to be unconstitutional or invalid.

SECTION 11.00 EMERGENCY

11.01 In the opinion of the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Archuleta, State of Colorado, an emergency exists for the immediate preservation of the health and safety of the citizens of the County of Archuleta, State of Colorado, therefore this ordinance shall become effective upon final adoption and placement of the appropriate traffic signs.
