### **Seasonal Wildland Firefighter – Supervisory Firefighter**

This is a temporary position that is responsible for assisting in the coordination of an initial attack squad whose duties include wildland fire management, fuels management, hazard assessment and emergency operations support. This position will be responsible for the supervision of temporary firefighters. The position will be utilized from April 7<sup>th</sup> to the end of September. This position requires competence with a variety of hand tools and power tools including, but not limited to, chainsaws, firing equipment and / or portable pumps. It also requires the operation of a variety of vehicles, including but not limited to fire engines, pickups and ATVs. This position will be responsible for keeping detailed records of work accomplished by the crew. Applicants must have a high school diploma or GED and three years experience as a wildland firefighter. Applicants must be qualified as a NWCG Engine Boss. Applicants will be required to pass a background check and must possess a valid driver's license. Applicants must be available for response 24 hours a day and may be required to work weekends. Salary range is \$17.00 to \$20.00 an hour.
