- - CO Parks =\$37,500 (50%)

- - 1A = \$18,750 (25%)
- - Wolf Creek Trail Blazers = \$18,750 (25%)
- The Club will own the truck and pay for Insurance.
- Wolf Creek Trail Blazers is a “not for profit” entity,

PROST moves the BoCC consider funding the Wolf Creek Trail Blazers for the full amount requested (\$18,750).
