Commissioners Approve 1A Fund Allocations

At their regular meeting on September 15, 2009, the Archuleta County Board of Commissioners reviewed, discussed and unanimously approved the 1A Fund allocations for 2010. After listening to public input and open discussion, the allocation of funds into each of the four categories was approved as follows:

1A Fund Category	2008	2009	2010
County Roads	40%	60%	60%
Information Technology and Training	20%	10%	12.5%
Parks and Recreation	20%	15%	12.5%
County Facilities	20%	15%	15%

In November, 2006 voters approved Ballot Measure 1A, stabilizing the property tax mill levy rate and removing the limitations of the Taxpayer's Bill of Rights (TABOR) for the next 5 years. A Commitment Letter was signed by the Board of County Commissioners in September, 2006 allocating 1A funding by percentage within four specified categories.

In preparation for the Fiscal Year 2010 budget, the Board of County Commissioners is involved in the determination of the allocation for each category. The 1A allocation for Fiscal Year 2010 is estimated to be in excess of \$1.5 million.
