**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF

**WHEREAS**, Part 1 of Article 25 of Title 31, Colorado Revised Statutes pertains to the Urban Renewal Law; and,

**WHEREAS**, C.R.S. § 31-25-104(2(a)(1) requires the URA to consist of thirteen commissioners, one of which must be appointed by the board of county commissioners; and,

**WHEREAS**, the URA recommends the appointment of County Assessor Natalie Woodruff as a commissioner of the Pagosa Springs Urban Renewal Authority for a term of one year.
