**Vacation Rental Referrals and Appeals**

Property Owner Hans Vlieger completed a Pre-Application Conference on 9/13/2018, and applied for Vacation Rental Permit VR18-039, accepted 10/26/18, for 5 bedrooms at his home at 68 Poplar Ct. The Assessor's record shows 4 bedrooms. Applicant appealed staff's determination that 4 bedrooms determines maximum occupancy for the property.

Applicant had arranged a teleconference, but was not available when called during the meeting. Commissioner Shahan then moved to continue this item to the Planning Commission's meeting on May 22, 2019. Commissioner Hooton seconded. Vote 5-0 aye.

**Vacation Rentals Permit Update:** Over 260 applications have been received to date, plus about 100 more are expected from VACASA. Staff has approved 100 permits and several more have had inspections and are ready for approval.

He attended the BoCC work session on 4/23, where Mr. Shepard highlighted the Text Amendments recommended by the Planning Commission.
